The seminar includes visits of laboratories at Ecole Polytechnique, Synchrotron SOLEIL and CEA Energies Alternatives at Saclay (20 km outside Paris). The meeting takes place at the French Ministry of Research and Higher Education.

The seminar is organized by the Norwegian Research Council, the French Ministry of Research and Higher Education, the French-Norwegian Foundation and the Embassies in both countries.
